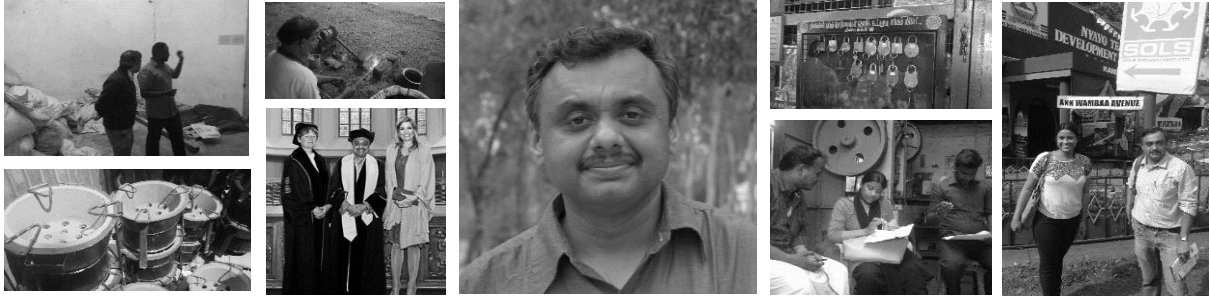


GRASSROOTS INNOVATION
